GUIDELINES FOR PAPER PRESENTERS

1. All respondents whose abstracts have been selected must submit their Registration Forms duly filled in within the due date – **10th January 2018**. For completed Registration Forms not received by email within 5 pm of the due date, it will be presumed that the respondent is not participating in the International Seminar.
2. Details of presentation schedule will be made available in the Seminar Kit to be collected at the Reporting/Registration Desk at NSOU on 13th January 2018 from 10 am to 11 am.
3. Presentations may be made in Bangla/English as this is a bilingual Seminar. Each presenter will be allowed 8 minutes time to put forth her/his views. Papers should preferably be **presented** (and not read out) so as to facilitate interactions.

Presenters will be expected to take note of suggestions received at the interactions, and enrich their final papers accordingly.

4. The organisers shall arrange for PowerPoint presentations for those who require the same. In such cases, all PPT's must be sent to the designated email id by 5 pm of 12th January 2018.
5. As part of the Seminar proceedings, all presentations may be videographed. Such footage will remain the exclusive rights of the Research Project under which this Seminar is being organised, and may be used as components of the Open Repository that is being developed on this theme.
6. All selected presenters are to submit their full length papers for publication as part of the project outcome by 30th June 2018. All such papers may be edited by reviewers in keeping with the focal theme(s) of the research project. It is expected that presenters will cooperate in an academic spirit in ensuring the quality of the final international publication to be made jointly by both universities.
7. It is the responsibility of the presenter to verify all details like name, institutional particulars, title of paper, contact details etc. Data entry for Seminar certificate and all further purposes pertaining to the research project shall be made on the basis of Registration Sheets duly signed by respondents/presenters.
8. Presence at all sessions of the Workshop cum Seminar is necessary for receiving the certificate of presentation/ participation.

১। প্রতিটি সংক্ষিপ্তসার উপস্থাপনের সময় ৮মিনিট। সময় সম্পর্কে সচেতনতা প্রার্থনীয়।

২। বাংলা ও ইংরেজি যে-কোনো একটি ভাষাতে উপস্থাপন করা যাবে।

৩। পাওয়ার-পয়েন্ট স্লাইড ব্যবহার করলে তা ১২জানুয়ারির মধ্যে নির্দিষ্ট ই-মেলে পাঠাতে হবে। অন্যথায় তা ব্যবহারযোগ্য হবে না।

৪। উপস্থাপনকে আকর্ষক করে তোলার প্রচেষ্টা থাকবে উপস্থাপকের। প্রদত্ত সূচি অনুযায়ী নির্দিষ্ট সময়ের পূর্বে উপস্থাপককে নির্দিষ্ট ঘরে উপস্থিত হতে হবে।

৫। প্রতিটি উপস্থাপনের ভিডিও রেকর্ডিং হবে। এই ভিডিও রেকর্ডের সর্বস্বত্ব প্রকল্প কর্তৃক সংরক্ষিত। প্রকল্প নির্দিষ্ট পরিকল্পনাক্রমে তা ওয়েবসাইট ও অন্যান্য বৈদ্যুতিন মাধ্যমে ব্যবহার করতে পারবে।



৬। উপস্থাপককে মূল বক্তব্য ও ভাবনা স্বচ্ছভাবে প্রকাশের দিকে জোর দিতে হবে। কীভাবে তিনি বিষয়কে দেখছেন এবং কী প্রশ্ন উত্থাপন করতে চাইছেন সে সম্পর্কে সচ্ছতা প্রত্যাশিত।

৭। শ্রোতৃমণ্ডলীর মধ্য থেকে উত্থাপিত প্রশ্ন গ্রহণ করে নিজের মতামত ব্যক্ত করবেন উপস্থাপক—এ প্রত্যাশা থাকবে।
